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The Importance of Stage Scheduling in Dance Creation - Taking' Far Mountain is Not Far Away' as an Example

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Abstract: Stage scheduling is to schedule the stage, schedule the position of the actors on the stage, also known as scene scheduling. In order to better show the central idea and connotation of the work, it is necessary to design and arrange the actors on the stage, which is called stage scheduling in drama. This paper mainly describes what is stage scheduling, stage scheduling methods and stage scheduling in the role and application of dance choreography. The basic content of dance creation is innovation and thinking ability. In order to achieve a more ideal stage effect, the application of stage scheduling in dance creation is indispensable. There are two main functions of stage scheduling: action scheduling and lyrical scheduling. Therefore, in dance creation and dance expression, reasonable and appropriate sports dance moving lines can increase the beauty of dance and attract the attention of viewers.

This article combines the stage scheduling with the performance of the dance work' far mountain is not far away'. Using the scheduling theory and the method of work analysis, this paper elaborates the specific application of dance scheduling to analyze and summarize the function of dance scheduling in dance creation. Firstly, it will briefly introduce the concept of dance scheduling, and then explain the composition of dance scheduling through the choreography process of dance ' far mountain is not far away ', and summarize the function of scheduling in dance.

alleviation. He delicately depicts his wife carrying a schoolbag into the 'far mountain', the unsuitable life, the friendship of the children, the husband's resolutely walking with his wife, and the growing children carrying the teacher's schoolbag confidently out of the mountain.

In the first paragraph, the dance begins, the heroine has been looking to the distance, is very focused. At this time, her husband came on the stage with a backpack, seemingly thinking of sending her off. He saw his wife looking far away for a long time, and knew that his wife was reminded of the children waiting for teaching in the remote poor mountainous areas. He smiled helplessly and pulled up his wife 's hand. Although he knew that his wife had decided to help the children who were eager for knowledge, he still could not put down his heart and tried to retain his wife. The heroine is naturally reluctant to give up, but she is a teacher. She has her mission. She remembers those lovely children who are eager for knowledge in the depths of the mountains, or she resolutely chooses to carry a backpack and take root in the mountains alone to help those children who need knowledge to change their destiny. The picture turns to the children in the mountain area, who are lying at the school gate and seem to be waiting for the arrival of the new volunteer teacher.

The second paragraph, look! It seems that the new teacher came, the children looked excitedly together, the result is only wrong, and lost back. At this time, in order to express the dynamic of the picture and the beauty of the passage of time due to the difference between time and space, the main means of dance picture scheduling is comparison.

The beauty of contrast can be seen everywhere in life and self-heating, which can make art perfect. Therefore, dance is more afraid of the insipidity of stage pictures, and the comparison of pictures on dance scheduling is necessary. In the first paragraph of 'Not far from the mountain', the opening is first the double dancers enter from the left side of the stage, and the group dance is placed on the back side of the stage. On the one hand, it reflects the reluctant departure of the couple, and the low music highlights the pain of this parting. On the other hand, the children in the mountainous areas are sending away the teachers and are eager for the arrival of the new teachers. They are waiting

for or eager for knowledge.

3.2 Shaping the character image

The dance starts with the horizontal line scheduling of the double dance, and introduces the dance protagonists Hu Zhong and Xie Xiao-jun.
