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The Transformation of Teacher's Role and the Cultivation of Students' Innovative Ability in English Education

Combine English with topics in cutting-edge fields such as science and technology, economy, and environmental protection to guide students to pay attention to social hot spots and enhance their sense of mission; Integrate English with music, art, drama and other art forms to cultivate students' sentiment and enhance their aesthetic taste. For example, teachers can introduce British and American classic literature works, organize students to read, adapt and perform in different roles, and at the same time experience the charm of English, understand life philosophy, and cultivate critical thinking and innovative expression skills. Teachers can also guide students to express their views and debate in English based on current affairs and hot topics. In the process of exchanging ideas and demonstrating viewpoints, teachers can improve their logical thinking ability and contingency expression ability.

3. Strategies for cultivating students' innovative ability in college English teaching

3.1 Encourage students to engage in exploratory learning and ask open questions

In the information age, the ways of knowledge acquisition are increasingly diversified, and students are no longer the object of passive acceptance of knowledge, but the subject of active construction of knowledge. 3.2 Carry out a variety of classroom activities, such as role play, group discussion, etc

Using virtual reality, augmented reality and other immersive learning environment, let students experience cultural differences in the simula-



tion situation, enhance cross-cultural communication awareness; Intelligent teaching tools such as big data and artificial intelligence are used to analyze students' learning conditions, provide personalized learning support, and promote the release of innovation potential. For example, teachers can guide students through English video resources such as TED talks and BBC News to understand the trends of cutting-edge science and technology, grasp the pulse of the development of The Times, open up an international perspective, and inspire innovation. Teachers can also encourage students to use information technology to build cross-cultural communication platforms, and carry out network collaboration and cooperative research with foreign students, so as to deepen understanding and promote innovation through exchanges and mutual learning.
